

MINUTES
PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE
APRIL 17, 2019

The Public Works Committee met on April 17, 2019, at 4:30 p.m. in the Council Chambers at City Hall.

Present: Chairman Gould, Alderman Hughes, Alderman Sharp, Mayor White, City Engineer Coulter, Superintendent Sutherland, Office Manager Passage
Also Present: Brandon Pumphrey

Chairman Gould called the meeting to order.

PUBLIC COMMENT

No public comment

HIGH USAGE WAIVER

Office Manager Passage stated that one high usage waiver request was received from Brandon Pumphrey, 1608 Finney. Superintendent Sutherland stated that he met with the Mr. Pumphrey and the water did not go back through the system. The amount to be considered to waive, is \$94.35. The consensus of the committee is to waive \$94.35.

Office Manager Passage reported back to the committee the amounts that the Sanitary District waived on the last four high usage waiver request.

PROJECT UPDATE

Engineer Coulter gave an update regarding Tri-County's progress in preparing GIS base maps. He stated that at the first public works meeting in May he will discuss the sealcoating, spray patching and overlay of TIF funded streets.

Engineer Coulter presented the updated Zoning Map.

REPAIR DUMP TRUCK

Superintendent Sutherland stated that the 2015 International Dump Truck was damaged. An employee while plowing did not see low hanging branch and branch hit truck. He stated that he obtained a estimate from Resurrection Welding to make the repairs in the amount of \$9,000.00. It was turned into the insurance company and an appraiser reviewed the estimate and the insurance paid the claim for \$9,000.00, for the repair. The consensus of the committee was to seek approval for the repair at the April 22 council meeting.

MOSQUITO SPRAY

Superintendent Sutherland presented a proposal to purchase mosquito spray, from Clarke. Cost for the mosquito spray is \$4,021.21. The consensus of the committee was to seek approval at the April 22, council meeting.

GEAR BOX

Superintendent Sutherland stated that the brush hog mower needed a new gear box. He presented a proposal from German-Bliss in the amount of \$805.19. The consensus of the committee was to seek approval at the April 22, council meeting.

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Alderman Hughes asked about the drainage on Hushaw and Elm as there is still an issue at that site. Engineer Coulter stated that the long range plan is to run the storm sewer to that area, however; it is very costly. Superintendent Sutherland stated that he will be cleaning the drywells again, which may help.
