

MINUTES
PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE
NOVEMBER 22, 2017

The Public Works Committee met on November 22, 2017, at 4:30 p.m., in the Council Chambers at City Hall.

Present: Chairman Gould, Alderman Sharp, Alderman Hughes, Alderman Jenkins, Engineer Coulter
Mayor White, Superintendent Sutherland

Chairman Gould called the meeting to order.

Repair of Easement Machine:

During the last call for the machine, the axle broke. The cost to repair the axle is \$1,269.91 and there are still sufficient funds in the line item for this work. Ko Equipment will do the repair. Committee agreed to send this item to council and recommends approval.

High Usage Waivers:

Hilda Court location. House is in probate and vacant. The stool ran for some time but has been shut off at this time. The City portion to waive is \$56.86. Committee agreed to waive. Office manager will send to Sanitary District.

610 N. Benedict location: Jennifer had a stool running and it is now fixed by her husband. Shawn has inspected the work and reported it was all new parts. The resident received two bills, one for \$347 and one for \$354. The problem was repaired after the first bill was received but late in the cycle of the second bill. The committee agreed to waive the City portion of the first invoice dated October 11. Office manager will send to Sanitary District. The committee recommended that Jennifer return to the next committee meeting, December 6th to review the second invoice. The committee indicated that she would not get charged a late fee during this review period and the water will not be shut off.

Second Street Parking:

The committee discussed the parking restrictions invoked previously that have been revoked. Shawn indicated that sweeping has not been an issue since they begin early. No changes were recommended.

Goldberg Request for Three Sisters Park:

Three Sisters Park refused the Goldberg request to place aggregate in several areas. The scope of the work was reduced to the north-south road only. The work is expected to be done soon unless the weather does not allow the work to be done. The Mayor reported that he had Three Sisters Park sign off on the current scope of work.

There being no further business the meeting adjourned at 5:10 p.m.
