Riversound Park – Bike Rack:

Superintendent Sutherland reported that he had estimates in the amount of \$309.00 for the bike rack and \$570.00 for concrete work. Discussion was held. Chairman Jenkins will review the budget to see if there is money allocated. He will report back at next month's meeting.

Porta Potty - Parks:

Chairman Jenkins opened discussion in regards to a request for a porta potty at Riversound Park. Chairman Jenkins received a cost estimate from Office Manager Passage in the amount of \$66.63. per month. Alderman Hughes spoke strongly in favor of placing porta potty at all city parks that do not have facilities. A lengthy discussion was held. It was the consensus to look at the budget and discuss at next month's meeting.

Sycamore Trail Park:

Chairman Jenkins led discussion. The consensus of the committee was to have funds received from fundraising events paid out to the Non for Profit Committee – Prairie Springs Playground, Inc. Mayor White will move forward on a Request for Proposal for the park.
