PUBLIC COMMENT

Cary Carr of 1616 David addressed the committee. He voiced his concern regarding the crosswalk at Cloverdale Road and Stanley. His concern was the placement of the sign in the crosswalk because when turning east onto Cloverdale road from Stanley it is hard to avoid hitting the sign. He also stated that it is hard to turn if there is a car parked on the side of the roadway. Mayor White stated that he and Superintendent Sutherland would review the situation with the sign in the crosswalk.
