BUDGET 2020-2021:

Chief Mettille informed the committee that he had completed his budget for the upcoming budget session in March. Chief Mettille gave a brief overview of the budget and a short discussion was held on the possible fuel cost sharing with the School District.

SRO AGREEMENT & MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING:

Chief Mettille gave an overview of the police fleet. He asked the committee to approve the purchase of a new Tahoe off of the State Bid from a dealership in Decatur, in the amount of \$37,122.00. Discussion was held. The committee asked Chief Mettille to contact Riverside Chevrolet in regards to purchasing through them. It was the consensus of the committee to seek council approval for the purchase through the Decatur dealership or Riverside Chevrolet.
