MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING  
FEBRUARY 28, 2011**

The City Council of the City of Chillicothe, Peoria County, Illinois, met in Regular Session February 28, 2011. Mayor Childers called the meeting to order at 7:00 P.M.

**Chairman Childers declared a Quorum Present.**

The Minutes of the Regular Council Meeting held on February 14, 2011, were presented.

Motion Alderman Cantwell, second Alderman Block, that the Council dispense with the reading of the Minutes of the February 14, 2011 Council meeting, and to approve the Minutes, as presented. Motion carried via voce vote.

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Clerk Crabel presented the City Engineer's Report dated February 28, 2011.

Clerk Crabel presented the Economic Development Director's Revolving Loan Fund Report for the month ending January 31, 2011.

Clerk Crabel presented a Benedict Street Bridge Inspection Report, as conducted and inspected by the A E Com. The report was mailed to the Illinois Department of Transportation on February 21, 2011, by Associate Engineers of A E Com, Philip J. Lane and Donald B. Bell.

Clerk Crabel presented a draft of a Strategic Plan for Illinois Valley Central District #321, as submitted by Dr. Nick Polyak, IVC Superintendent.

Dr. Nick Polyak appeared before the Council and invited the Council members to attend a Strategic Plan Community Input Night, to be held at South Primary School, on Wednesday, March 9, 2011, at 6:00 P.M.

The Chairmen of the Council Committees gave brief activity reports.

William Dwyer, of 209 N. Second Street, appeared before the Council to request that at the March 14, 2011 Council meeting, an Agenda Item be listed on the Agenda to rescind the time limit parking Ordinance on the downtown streets.

Alderman Underwood, Chairman of the Judicial Committee stated that, at the present time, it has not been decided on whether or not to rescind the said Ordinance.
