We are planning events for next year's Arbor Day, April 27, 2018. We are going to use the Pin Oak trees that are in our "nursery", to replace a tree that died next to a young man's grave. We are planning on offering the remaining trees in the nursery, 27 Ash trees, with the stipulation that they might not survive the approaching Ash Borer epidemic. Myron spoke about the land across from Chillicothe Park District property, Shore Acres, as it's going to be cleared and made presentable. This is in cooperation with the railroad that runs alongside.
